Merchandise Vendor Fact Sheet

NUMBER OF SPACES: There are approximately 15-20 spaces (10' x 10') in the merchandise vendor area

SET UP TIMES: All vendors are required to set up the day before the festival/event officially opens to the public. Tear down is the day after the festival/event ends.

COST: Per space 10' x 10', per festival/event

John Hartford Memorial Festival | May 27-30 | 4 days | \$400 (10' x10) or \$500 (10'x20')

Bean Blossom Bluegrass Festival | June 13-20 | 8 days | \$600

Bean Blossom Southern Gospel Jubilee | July 9-11 | 3 days | \$250

Hippy Hill Dead Fest | July 31 & August 1 | 2 days | \$100

Uncle Pen Fest | September 23-26 | 4 days | \$300

DEPOSIT: 50% of your total booth space fee per event, payable within 15 days of acceptance of application, with a copy of your insurance rider. **ALL DEPOSITS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. Receipt of application DOES NOT insure acceptance.
2. Once your application and list of items has been accepted, you will be required to mail in your deposit and your insurance company's certificate of insurance naming **R&B Festivals INC., and Bill Monroe Music Park INC., AS ADDITIONALLY INSURED. This must be received within 15 days of acceptance.**
3. All merchandise vendors will be in the designated area.
4. Merchandise may be sold from a stand or canopy (tent). Note the state Fire Marshall's Fire Code Requirements.
5. Every effort will be made to select a wide variety of merchandise offerings as possible for each festival/event. Vendors may not sell any illegal items.
6. Please note that certain items may be deemed ineligible due to the Festival's agreement with the promoter.

7. You will need provide your own connectors to be plugged into our 110/220 outlets. We have 30- and 50-amp service. If you do not have the required plug, you will need to purchase one before connecting. **NO DIRECT HARD-WIRED CONNECTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED.**

8. Electrical wattage must be noted on application – 110/220 amps and amps needed.

9. Spaces are 10' deep or wide, and 10' in length. **IF YOU REQUIRE MORE, YOUR WILL NEED TO RENT ADDITIONAL SPACES TO MEET YOUR REQUIREMENTS.**

10. Vendors are responsible for providing their own trash containers and picking up trash in their immediate area, keeping their area clean from all trash debris.

11. Fire extinguishers are required.

12. At least 1 trash container is required outside each spot which is provided by the vendor.

13. Selling of all items must be done within your assigned space and from inside your tent area.

14. All items that you wish to sell must be listed your application with prices. These prices may not be changed once your application is approved. **No alcoholic beverages permitted**

15. You may be asked to delete items to avoid duplications.

16. Please include a recent picture of your merchandise vendor set up.

SPECIAL NOTES:

The Indiana State Fire Marshall has mandated that all vendors must comply with the Indiana Fire Code. The following are some of the requirements that must be met in order to be a vendor at Bill Monroe Music Park and Campground.

1. All temporary membrane structures, tents or canopies must be properly labeled with the size and fabric or material type.

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
